To all Marion County residents and park patrons:

An essential part of operating our parks involves maintaining the health and safety of our staff and visitors like you. Marion County Parks and Recreation understands the seriousness of COVID-19 and will be taking the precautionary measures outlined below. We will continue to adapt as the situation evolves.

Until further notice:

- All athletic fields will be closed. There will be no team practices or gatherings permitted on the fields. This follows the cancellation of extracurricular activities and the closing of public schools by the Board of Education and the Governor of West Virginia.
- All restrooms at MCPARC facilities will also be closed.

- Facilities rentals, including park pavilions and the Police Reserve building, are suspended through May 10th. MCPARC will work with groups already scheduled to postpone or cancel as needed.
